## Mission

The Mayflower's primary purpose is territorial defense. The Mayflower accomplishes this mission primarily through border duty and system patrol.



## Background

The destruction of the *Kelvin* was the divergence point between the prime universe timeline and the alternate timeline that was created with that ship's destruction. In the original timeline, the Miranda-class would be launched in the same year as the Mayflower, 2243. Thanks

to its reverse-engineered technology, compared to its prime universe counterpart the Mayflower is significantly better-armed, better protected, and faster. Unfortunately for the Mayflower, even with its enhancements, it was still no match for the *Narada* in the Battle of Vulcan.

## Features

The Mayflower is the first Federation design to incorporate reverse-engineered technology from the encounter with the *Narada*. With its enhanced phasers and photon torpedoes, it sports the firepower and defense of a heavy cruiser a generation ahead of its time.

As has become standard in this new era for the Federation, the Mayflower features redundant life support systems.

## Alternate Timeline Availability

The arrival of the *Narada* from 154 years in the future had a profound effect on not just Federation history, but the history of the entire Alpha Quadrant. The *Kelvin's* survivors escaped the *Narada* with detailed scans of the ship from the future, enough for the brightest minds of Starfleet to reverse engineer some of the technology they witnessed, putting the Federation decades ahead of where it should have been in its systems, particularly with weapons and shields.
